Lt Col Joseph J. Wingo is the Director of Cyberspace Professional Continuing Education (PCE), Air Force Institute of Technology. Cyberspace PCE develops and executes the Air Force's Cyberspace 200, Cyberspace 300, and Advanced Cyber Education courses. His team educates 650 Cyberspace professionals per year on the application of cyberspace to operational warfare planning and national strategy.

Lt Col Wingo was commissioned through the Officer Training School in January 1999. Prior to this assignment, he commanded the 628<sup>th</sup> Communications Squadron and the 690<sup>th</sup> Network Support Squadron, Detachment 2. In addition, he has been a lead Base Communications Planner, a Network Administrator, a base level Communications Flight Commander, and a base level Deputy Communications Squadron Commander. Lt Col Wingo deployed to Baghdad, Iraq as a Communication Planner. He was responsible for the planning, engineering, and installation of communications capabilities supporting the Department of Defense, the Department of State, and the Iraqi National Government. Additionally, he has been an Officer Training School Instructor and an Inspector for the Air Force Inspector General's Office.
